We provide evidence to inform patient care, service improvement, research and clinical teaching. Following are some of the Evidence searches we have carried out for Emergency Medicine


- Emergency resuscitation of hypothermia Rate of rewarming process Role of prehospital rewarming Declaring death in hypothermic states When to transfer to ECMO (or other invasive interventions)
- Emergency tracheostomy care
- Determining staffing levels in the emergency department
- The use of ct kub(kidney ureter, bladder) in the emergency department for patient having undifferentiated abdominal pain with normal blood test and normal examination will give diagnosis other than urinary tract pathology and reduce the admission length.
