# DynaMed Plus Topic Updates: (NHS OPENATHENS LOGIN required to access DynaMed topics)

Covid-19 in pregnant patients: COVID-19 vaccination does not appear to decrease rate of clinical pregnancy in persons having assisted reproductive treatment (Fertil Steril 2023 Jan 23 early online)

COVID-19 vaccination during pregnancy does not appear to increase risk of adverse neonatal outcome and may be associated with decreased risk of preterm birth (BMC Pregnancy Childbirth 2023 Jan 20)

Chorioamnionitis: Chorioamnionitis associated with increased risk of adverse neonatal outcomes, including increased need for ventilation (J Matern Fetal Neonatal Med 2022 Dec)

Cervical ripening for labor induction with unfavourable cervix: modified CCRB with uterine balloon inflated to 120 mL and vaginal balloon inflated to 40 mL may increase delivery rate within 24 hours and shorten duration of labor compared to conventional CCRB with both balloons inflated to 80 mL in patients with singleton primiparous pregnancy at term and Bishop score ≤ 6 points (BMC Pregnancy Childbirth 2022 Oct 2)

Fetal monitoring during labor: in patients with singleton term pregnancy who have abnormal cardiotocography, additional monitoring by digital fetal scalp stimulation might decrease risk of cesarean section compared to additional monitoring by fetal blood sampling (Cochrane Database Syst Rev 2023 Jan 10)

Management of routine labor: AZithromycin slightly decreases risk of maternal sepsis but not composite risk of stillbirth, neonatal death, and neonatal sepsis in persons in labor at ≥ 28 weeks gestation planning vaginal delivery (N Engl J Med 2023 Feb 9 early online)

Preterm premature rupture of membranes (PPROM): single 1,000-mg dose of azithromycin may prolong latency period and reduce risk of postpartum endometritis and neonatal respiratory distress syndrome compared to Z-Pak dosing in patients with singleton pregnancy at 24-36 6/7 weeks gestation and PPROM (BMC Pregnancy Childbirth 2022 Nov 23)
