Cochrane Clinical Answers:

How does dexamethasone compare with betamethasone for women and babies at risk of preterm birth?

Clinical Answer: For women at risk of preterm birth, the effect of dexamethasone compared with betamethasone is uncertain for maternal outcomes (chorioamnionitis, infection requiring the use of antibiotics, or adverse effects of therapy) and for fetal, neonatal, and child outcomes (death, respiratory distress syndrome, intraventricular hemorrhage, chronic lung disease, necrotizing enterocolitis, birthweight, neurodevelopmental disability, developmental delay, cerebral palsy, neonatal intensive care unit admission, or visual and hearing impairment). Reviewers found no studies assessing maternal death or puerperal sepsis.

Antidepressant use in pregnancy and lactation: Antidepressant use between gestational week 19 and delivery associated with small increased risks of each of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), developmental speech and language or communication disorders, and behavioral disorders (JAMA Intern Med 2022 Oct 3)

Covid-19 and pregnancy: Return of COVID-19 symptoms reported in 33.3% of vaccinated pregnant patients completing full 5-day course of nirmatrelvir/ritonavir for mild SARS-CoV-2 infection (Obstet Gynecol 2023 Mar 16 early online)

Early-onset neonatal sepsis: Among preg30nant persons ≥ 16 years old, intrapartum azithromycin orally may not reduce composite risk of neonatal sepsis and death (JAMA 2023 Mar 7)

Hypertensive disorders of pregnancy: Preeclampsia and other hypertensive disorder of pregnancy each associated with increased risk of ischemic heart disease in birthing parent (BMJ 2023 Feb 1)

Induced abortion: In patients with low risk of ectopic pregnancy, very early medical abortion prior to ultrasound confirmation of intrauterine pregnancy does not appear to increase ectopic pregnancy rate compared to medical abortion after confirmation and may reduce duration of care without affecting likelihood of complete abortion (BMJ Sex Reprod Health 2022 Nov 9 early online)

Preterm labor: Single course of antenatal betamethasone at ≤ 22 6/7 weeks gestation may be associated with increased survival to hospital discharge and survival without major morbidity among infants born between 22 and 23 6/7 weeks gestation (JAMA Netw Open 2022 Sep 1)

Intrauterine growth restriction (IUGR): Having SGA infant associated with increased risk of ischemic heart disease in birthing parent (BMJ 2023 Feb 1)

Lactational mastitis: Oral probiotics during pregnancy may decrease risk of lactational mastitis (PLoS One 2022)

Postpartum management: Early IUD placement at 2-4 weeks postpartum appears to have similar risk of complete expulsion compared to IUD placement at 6-8 weeks postpartum in adults following vaginal or cesarean birth (JAMA 2023 Mar 21)

Twin-Twin Transfusion Syndrome: Solomon technique may reduce perinatal mortality but may increase placental abruption compared to selective fetoscopic laser photocoagulation in monochorionic twin pregnancies complicated by twin-twin transfusion syndrome (Ultrasound Obstet Gynecol 2022 Dec)
