# DynaMed Plus Topic Updates: (NHS OPENATHENS LOGIN required to access DynaMed topics)

Abdominal trauma in pregnancy: Among adults who experience blunt abdominal trauma after 23 weeks gestation, abdominal pain or tenderness or vaginal bleeding may not be associated with increased preterm delivery (J Matern Fetal Neonatal Med 2022 Dec)

Breech presentation: Addition of moxibustion to usual care may reduce noncephalic presentation at birth in patients with singleton breech presentation (Cochrane Database Syst Rev 2023 May 9)

Caesarean section: Tranexamic acid immediately after umbilical cord clamping may not reduce risk of maternal death and blood transfusion in adults having cesarean delivery (N Engl J Med 2023 Apr 13)

Scheduled IV ketorolac for 6 doses reduces postoperative opioid use at 72 hours compared to 2 doses in patients ≥ 16 years old having cesarean delivery (Obstet Gynecol 2023 Apr 1)

Among adults with full-term singleton pregnancy having elective cesarean delivery with epidural anesthesia, esketamine IV before incision improves sedation but may not decrease pain immediately after delivery (JAMA Netw Open 2023 Apr 3)

Cervical ripening for labor induction with unfavourable cervix: Addition of single-dose propranolol orally to vaginal misoprostol may shorten time to delivery but may not increase rate of vaginal delivery in primiparous persons with singleton pregnancy at full term in cephalic presentation (BMC Pregnancy Childbirth 2023 Apr 4)

Covid-19 in pregnant patients: mRNA COVID-19 vaccine booster dose in pregnancy may increase risk of medically attended acute malaise or fatigue at 7 days and lymphadenopathy or lymphadenitis at 21 and 42 days (Obstet Gynecol 2023 May 11 early online)

Hysterectomy: Bilateral salpingo-oophorectomy during benign hysterectomy associated with increased mortality and increased risks of cancer and cardiovascular disease in adults age ≥ 20 years (Ann Intern Med 2023 Apr 18 early online)

Menopause: Fezolinetant 45 mg once daily may reduce frequency and severity of daily vasomotor symptoms in patients ≤ 65 years old with moderate-severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause (J Clin Endocrinol Metab 2023 Feb 3 early online)

Treatment of infertility in women: Duostim protocol for ovarian stimulation may not increase oocyte retrieval or live births compared to single stimulation in 2 consecutive cycles in patients with poor ovarian response having IVF (Hum Reprod 2023 May 2)

Prednisone starting at onset of endometrial preparation for frozen-thawed embryo transfer with good-quality blastocyst or embryo does not improve live birth rate in patients with recurrent implantation failure (JAMA 2023 May 2)

Among couples with unexplained or mild male subfertility, IUI performed within 90 minutes of semen processing may decrease likelihood of ongoing pregnancy compared to IUI performed at ≥ 180 minutes of semen processing (Hum Reprod 2023 May 2)

Trial of labour after caesarean section (TOLAC): Higher intrauterine pressure, greater cervical dilation, and younger gestational age at birth associated with increased likelihood of successful VBAC in patients with 1-2 prior cesarean deliveries (BJOG 2022 May)

Vasa previa: Combination of transabdominal and transvaginal color Doppler ultrasound has good predictive value for diagnosing vasa previa with velamentous cord insertion in adults with singleton pregnancy at 22-36 weeks gestation (J Environ Public Health 2022)
